Community-Based Group Training

- Maximum of four (4) students per group
- School staff on-site with students
- Ongoing evaluation of student progress by school staff

Community-Based Individualized Training

- Students placed individually
- These students have previous work experience and placements will be based on student interests and abilities
- School staff assistance available if necessary during initial training and throughout placement
- Periodic evaluations of student progress completed by school staff.
