

**Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan Reconfirmation
Required 30 Days after Initial Plan Approval and Every Month Thereafter**

Requirements:

- Reconfirm how instruction is going to be delivered during the 20/21 school year
- Public comments from parents and/or guardians on the Extended Learning Plan
- Review weekly 2-way interaction rates

Reconfirmation Items for November

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

The Lapeer ISD is utilizing in-person instruction in its programs involving K-12 students. This instructional delivery method is altered only in the event of another mandated shutdown of school, the result of a recommendation from the Lapeer Health Department for closure or quarantine, or should one of its early college partners choose to provide instruction virtually. Should any of these situations occur, the ISD implements its plan for virtual instruction, outlined in its 2020-21 Preparedness and Response Plan.

Note: By way of the MDHHS Public Health Order on November 15, 2020 prohibiting face-to-face instruction for high school students, all Career and Technical Education instruction will be delivered virtually as outlined in the Preparedness and Response Plan. It is our intent to return to in-person instruction on December 9, 2020.

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

The delivery method of instruction for each grade level in the Center Program is in-person. As outlined above, instruction for high schools students in the Career and Technical Program as well as those students in the STEMM Academy early college program will be conducted virtually through December 8th, 2020.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

The Lapeer ISD has established structures for general and special education teachers and/or providers to collaborate and communicate regarding student performance and student needs on IEP goals and objectives with special consideration regarding assistive technology and accessibility.

The ISD ensures a continuation of services for students receiving speech and language, occupational therapy, physical therapy, or social work services within their IFSP or IEP. The district also ensures a method for the continuation of evaluation for students suspected of having a disability as well as those requiring re-evaluation.
