The Lapeer County ISD is seeking to contract with an electrician who has a valid State of Michigan electrician license to perform the following services:

- Conduct an initial inspection of the house being constructed by students in the Construction Trades program ("house") prior to the commencement of the electrical work
- Explain to the students what electrical requirements/codes must be met/complied with
- Obtain an electrical permit
- Conduct a final inspection of the house upon completion of the electrical work prior to the final State inspection.
